Ios is a party island in the Greek peninsula, located in the Cycladic cluster. A beautiful and picturesque island with a bustling nightlife, it is a popular destination for many young tourists and partygoers.

You can get there by ferry from Piraeus, as well as connections with various other islands. Many arrive via plane to either Santorini or Naxos, then take a short ferry ride to the main port. From the port of Yalos, use our Ios map to make your way to the island, from its villages full of whitewashed houses and domed chapels to its party destinations of beaches, tavernas, bars and clubs. You can stay up for 24 hours and never be bored in this place.

So much of the party scene has been written about Ios that many forget the beauty of the island itself. Use our map of Ios to find your way in to Hora, the main town. Enjoy the sights of the traditional village architecture, maze-like streets, windmills, and the standing medieval castle from the 1400's. Travel the island to Agia Theodoti where you can see an ancient aqueduct and a tower from classical times. Other cultural places of note include Homer's Tomb and the Agios Ioannis Monastery.

While nightlife may be the fuel for visitors to the island, the beaches are its treasure. Traverse the coastline from our map of Ios to see where the best beaches are located from wherever you are staying. Notable beaches include: Mylopotas, with over 1 km of seemingly endless, golden sand, it is the busiest beach on the island and the prime destination for many of the revelers traveling to Ios; Managanari, a truly captivating place that houses 4 beaches with long stretches of sand and beautiful blue water; Agia Theodoti, which has a large, sheltered bay and is one of the best places to watch the Greek sunrise.

Ios is the mecca of the young and if your desire is to party with fervor, visit this magnificent island and indulge in its vibrant flavor.
